

2012 youthconnect grants

The South Australian Government is committed to supporting young people aged between 12 and 25 to achieve positive outcomes.

Funding of \$500,000 is now available for projects that support the implementation of **youthconnect** South Australia's Youth Strategy 2010-2014, across the following priority areas:

Health and Wellbeing - keeping young people safe from harm

Education, Employment and Skill Development - supporting disengaged young people (17-19 years of age) to re-engage in education, leading to a qualification

Engagement and Participation - providing opportunities for young people to be actively engaged in their local communities

Better Connections - developing practical guidelines, tools and resources to better support organisations that work with young people

Non-government and not-for-profit organisations, as well as Youth Advisory Committees, are now invited to submit an application of between \$10,000 and \$50,000 for projects to be delivered over a 12 month period. Funding is non-recurrent and must be matched either dollar for dollar or through in-kind support.
